

SANITARY SEWER COMMISSION MINUTES June 28th, 2016 – 6:06 PM

PRESENT: Commissioners: Chair, Todd Larson, Howard Levo, Operator John Stack, Maintenance Jim Dawson, and Swan Dawson.

MINUTES: Motion to approve May meeting minutes by Larson, second by Levo. MC

CORRESPONDENCE: S. Dawson reported receiving notification the DNR Lake Study Grant has been finalized and the remaining money due the Village will be coming soon.

NEW BUSINESS: None

OLD BUSINESS Action Items: CMOM was reviewed. Motion to approve CMOM by Larson, second by Levo. MC The monitoring of grease traps in commercial kitchens was discussed. Stack reported some municipalities require businesses to submit paid invoices for cleanout services. It was decided this issue would become an action item for research and discussion this winter.

MAINTENANCE: J. Dawson reported the manhole markers are up on Highway F, the pole at Station 3 has been taken care of, the pipe cap has been fixed with blacktop at Station 1, the ponds are mowed and sprayed, birch trees have been removed, and we are waiting for gas lines to be marked before setting the No Parking signs.

OPERATOR'S REPORT: Stack reported the disposable wipes continue to be a problem. Grinders and traps do help minimize the problem in other municipalities. There are class action lawsuits pending regarding this issue nationwide. Stack reported the grit pile was processed and discussed future procedures for handling it in the future. The absence of cattails at the ponds was discussed. Possible overspraying? The ratio Lake Nebagamon uses is 2 ½ gallons of Rodeo to 500 gallons of water. Larson made a motion to test the wetlands for herbicide, second by Levo. MC Stack will initiate testing.
