

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES

May 26, 2020 - 6:00 pm

Meeting was called to order by Chair Fuller at 6:00pm.

Present: Chair Jake Fuller, Village President Darrell Kyle and Village Trustee Eric Anderson were present. Also present was Village Clerk Daisha Nolan, Village Administrator Amy K. Huber, and Village Marshall Pete Witt.

Review of Agenda: No changes made.

Public Input: No public input.

Minutes: A motion was made by Kyle to approve the meeting minutes from April 28, 2020 as presented, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Village Property Set Up:

Auditorium: A motion was made by Kyle to recommend to the board that no Auditorium use be allowed at this time, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Ball Fields: Correspondence from Ryan Teal was shared with the committee regarding Quad City League Baseball. A motion was made by Kyle to forward Ryan Teal's request for ball field usage, with requested measurables, to the Board, seconded E. Anderson. MCU

Beach: The committee reviewed keeping this open as it is a public space. A motion was made by Kyle to recommend to the Board to place the raft out and open bathrooms from 9-3 Monday through Friday with a minimum of 2 cleanings a day, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Campground: A motion was made by Kyle to have the Campground follow the same guidelines set in place for the Auditorium events, with no camping allowed at this time, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Downtown Speed Limits: A motion was made by Kyle to forward the motion made at the June 20, 2019 Public Safety Meeting to recommend to the Board that the following roads located South of Cty Rd. B be posted with a 15 MPH speed limit: Fitch St, Maint St, Lake Ave, Waterfront Dr, 1st Ave, Ravine Park Dr and Broadway, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

An inquiry will be made with the County about options to reduce the speed limit on County Road B near the Ball Fields and Playground.

Correspondence: Road requests from the Classics by the Lake, LLC was reviewed. A motion was made by Fuller to forward the road request to the Board, contingent on a measurable plan to be presented from the club, seconded by E. Anderson. Kyle Abstained MCU

Pete Witt shared progress being made on the clean up of Harvey Circle. A follow up letter to park owners will be drafted by Kyle to provide a final date for expected clean up.

Information from the Chair: Fuller provided an update on COVID-19 precautions. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 23, 2020 at 6:00pm.
