Public Input: Tom Chambers was present to inquire about the potential to host the Lake Nebagamon Dance at the Auditorium in July.

Minutes: A motion was made by Kyle to approve the meeting minutes from May 26, 2020 as presented, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Village Property Set Up:

Auditorium: A motion was made by Kyle to recommend to the board that the Auditorium reopen for scheduled events and classes with a maximum occupancy of 150 (50%) , seconded by E. Anderson. MCU A motion was made by Kyle to recommend CDC guidelines be followed during Auditorium reopening, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Ball Fields: The ball field will remain operating under the guidelines set in place for those participating in Quad City Baseball League.

Beach: The beach will remain operating with the current schedule and guidelines set in place for maintaining bathroom cleanliness.

Campground: A motion was made by Kyle to have the Campground remain closed through July, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Vagrants Ordinance: This topic will be researched and an ordinance drafted for next month's committee meeting. Village Marshall Pete Witt requested that a specific ordinance be drafted for the expected treatment of the Armed Forces Tribute Wall.

Fire Signs: The potential cost of supplies and installation of compliant fire numbers was discussed. An ordinance will be drafted for the next committee meeting. Huber will look into adding the cost to the tax roll.
