

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES

August , 2020 - 6:00 pm

Meeting was called to order by Chair Fuller at 6:00pm.

Present: Chair Jake Fuller and Village President Darrell Kyle were present, Village Trustee Eric Anderson attend via online source. Also present was Village Clerk Daisha Nolan, Village Administrator Amy K. Huber, and Village Marshall Pete Witt.

Review of Agenda: No changes made.

Minutes: A motion was made by Kyle to approve the meeting minutes from July 28, 2020 as presented, seconded by Fuller. MCU

Public Input: None.

Fireworks Permit Review: Fuller presented a rough draft with changes to the existing firework permit. A revised version will be presented to the committee in September.

Child Safety Concerns: After consulting with the Village Attorney, an ordinance will be drafted surrounding this issue.

Fire Sign Ordinance: A rough draft ordinance was reviewed with questions regarding driveways servicing multiple residences. This will be read again at the next committee meeting in September.

Firewise: Trustees will review information on this topic for discussion at the next meeting.

Boat Launch Parking: Coordination with Public Works still needed. Issues will be researched for possible action next year.

Dogs at the Beach: A motion was made by Kyle to recommend to the Village Board that the area South of the Auditorium be designated a no dog area, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Village Events/ Property Opening:

Auditorium: A motion was made by Kyle to recommend to the Village Board that all future agreements will allow only one event to be held a per weekend, only one floor of the building to be rented at a time, with capacities set to 100 people upstairs and 20 people downstairs with violations of these guidelines resulting in a forfeiture of the deposit placed for the rental to the Village of Lake Nebagamon, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Campground: Ravine Park Campground will remain closed.

Baseball Field: The baseball field will continue scheduled games through Ryan Teal, with accurate communication on bathroom usage.

Auditorium Basement Bathrooms: A motion was made by Kyle to recommend to the Village Board that the basement level bathrooms at the Auditorium be kept on their regular schedule, closing after Labor Day, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU
