

VILLAGE BOARD MINUTES JUNE 11, 2021 – following public hearing on 4th Ave. N discontinuance

PRESENT: Meeting called to order at the Auditorium by Village President Jim Jonasen at 6:33pm. The following answered to roll call: President Jim Jonasen, Trustees Jake Fuller, Jim Smith, Jason Vee, Eric Anderson and Bob Anderson. Trustee Adam Buchanan and Clerk Daisha Nolan absent. Also present: Village Administrator Amy Huber.

POSTING: The agenda was posted at the Auditorium, Post Office, Midland Marketplace and the Village Website.

REVIEW OF AGENDA: No changes.

PUBLIC INPUT:

- A. **Dave Dinda & Bob Kaszynski** gave input on the proposed changes to the parade route.

CORRESPONDENCE: None

OTHER BUSINESS: 4th of July events, road closures and auxiliary law enforcement officers were discussed. A proposal was made and refined to alter the parade route to start at Trinity Lutheran church instead of the Car Wash. The idea of going down Main Street was discarded as the road is too narrow for large floats.

A motion was made by Smith to approve the requested road closures on July 3rd from 8am - 12pm for the Dragin' Tail run (at intersections of Lake Ave. & Main St., Lake Ave. & Dairy Queen Dr., and 1st Ave. & Waterfront Dr.), seconded by E. Anderson. MC Fuller abstained

A motion was made by Smith to approve the requested road closures on July 4th at 4pm for the parade (starting at Trinity Lutheran Church, going down 1st St., taking a left on 1st Ave., going over Cty. Rd. B, taking a right on Camp Nebagamon Dr., taking a left on Ravine Park Drive, taking a left on Waterfront Dr., taking a left on Lake Ave. crossing Cty. Rd. B, taking a left on Railroad. Ave and a left on 1st Ave. for another loop through town), seconded by E. Anderson. MC Fuller abstained.

Motion by Fuller to create a pedestrian zone on July 4th from the intersection of Lake & Main to just beyond Dockside, seconded by E. Anderson. MCU

Motion by Fuller to give the Safety Committee power to close streets on July 3rd and 4th as needed for traffic flow and pedestrian safety, seconded by Vee. MCU

At this point, a street dance will be held if a band can be secured. Considering the 4th is on a Sunday and the dance will be on Saturday, getting an extra officer for both days was discussed. A motion was made by B. Anderson to give Pete Witt the authority to secure whatever auxiliary help he deems necessary for the weekend, seconded by Smith. MCU
