Meeting was called to order by Chair Fuller at 6:30pm.

Present: Chair Jake Fuller and Village Trustee Jason Vee. Also present were Village Clerk Daisha Nolan, Village Administrator Amy K. Huber and Village Marshall Pete Witt. Village Trustee Eric Anderson was absent.

Minutes: A motion was made by Vee to approve the meeting minutes from June 22, 2021, as presented, seconded by Fuller. MCU

Mutual Aid: This item will be tabled until next month as discussion and information is pursued.

FireWorks Permit: Permits from Cadott and Bellevue were provided from Rick Somerfield from DSPS to review. The current permit used for Lake Nebagamon will continue to be edited.

Farmer's Market: The Nebagamon Community Association has requested the use of the public parking lot located on Waterfront Drive for the use of a farmer's market. A motion was made by Vee to recommend to the Board that NCA be allowed to use the public parking lot to host a Farmer's Market on Saturdays 7:30 AM to 12:30 PM from August 7 through September 11, with the potential to extend to October, seconded by Fuller. ATV Speed Limit Signs: The current Village ordinance, Chapter 19, was reviewed regarding ATV speeds. This will be tabled to allow for full committee discussion at the next meeting.

ARPA Spending Plan: Crisis counseling for fire department members has been put forward as a suggestion for ARPA. These services are required by DSPS and have not been implemented as of present.

Correspondence: A letter concerning light pollution from LouAnn Noltner was put forward from the previous Village Board meeting. The committee reviewed the letter but is not able to implement restrictions to lighting due to Act 55.

Information from the Chair: The Fire Department will soon have updated EPI Pens. The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for August 31, 2021 at 6:00pm.

Officer Pete Witt extended thanks and appreciation to Sheri Fuller and her efficient and educated response to accidents and medical calls in the area through LNVFD.
