Public Input: Marge Ahrens phoned into the meeting and shared public input towards the speed limits of atvs and utvs, especially on Main Street, in favor of no speed increases and request for routes to be reviewed to avoid traffic from UTVs and ATVs on Main Street.

FireWorks Permit: Permits will be required for those who are executing public displays.

ATV Speed Limit Signs: A motion was made by E. Anderson to recommend to the board to increase the speed for UTVs and ATVs to 15 mph, seconded by Vee. MCU

Fitch Park Hydrant: This hydrant needs to be cut and capped due to no longer being used by the fire department. A licensed person to assist with the process will be sought out.

ARPA Spending Plan: Crisis counseling for fire department members has been put forward as a suggestion for ARPA. These services are required by DSPS and have not been implemented as of present.

Budget Review: The committee was given last years finalized budget to being reviewing for the 2022 budget.
